



#### GMU BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS REGION 1 WAC 220-410-010

- Minor adjustment
- The elk drift fence serves as a portion of the boundary for GMUs 175 and 178
- The fence was extended ~3/4 of a mile
- Proposed change modifies the boundary accordingly


#### GMU BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS REGION 4 WAC 220-410-040

- Adjust the boundary for GMUs 407 and 454
- The current boundary description results in a very narrow portion of GMU 407 that is bordered to the east by GMU 460 and to the west by GMU 454
- This small area (~450 acres) of GMU 407 causes confusion and enforcement issues
- Proposed change would add shaded area to GMU 454
- No specific comment



## GMU BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS REGION 5 WAC 220-410-050


- Minor adjustment to the boundary for GMUs 568 and 572 that would shift
   ~75 acres (shaded area) to GMU 568
- Objective is to reduce hunter confusion



# GMU BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS REGION 5 WAC 220-410-050


- Add the portion of GMU 554 that is north of State Route 503 (shaded area) to GMU 556
- GMU 554 is a firearm restriction area
- Shaded area is ~6,400 acres and predominately public forestland (DNR)
- Objective is to reduce hunter confusion and alleviate enforcement issues





## GMU BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS REGION 5 WAC 220-410-050


- Formally adopt a change to the boundary description for GMUs 506 and 673 that was implemented as an emergency rule in 2020
- Change to this boundary was adopted in April 2020
- Landowner the change was unwarranted
- After consultation between Regional staff and the landowner, the boundary was changed back to what it was in 2019
- This is the only change associated with WAC 220-410-060







- This change will also apply to Deer Area 1040 (WAC 220-415-010)






- Modify the boundary of EA 2032

- Objective is to reduce hunter confusion and lessen enforcement issues






Establish a new Elk Area in GMU 603 near the town of Joyce






