Inequities are based on:

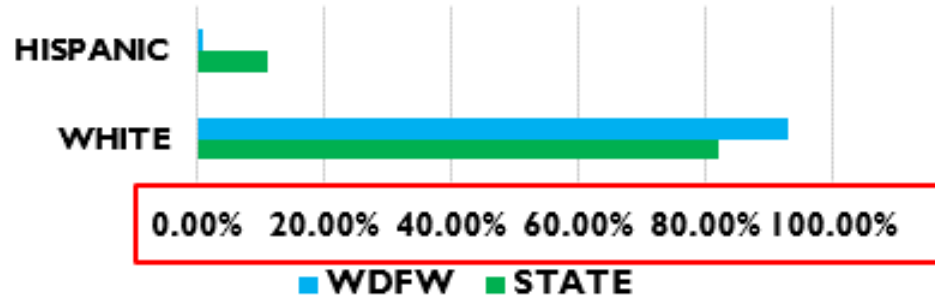
- Race

- Other characteristics



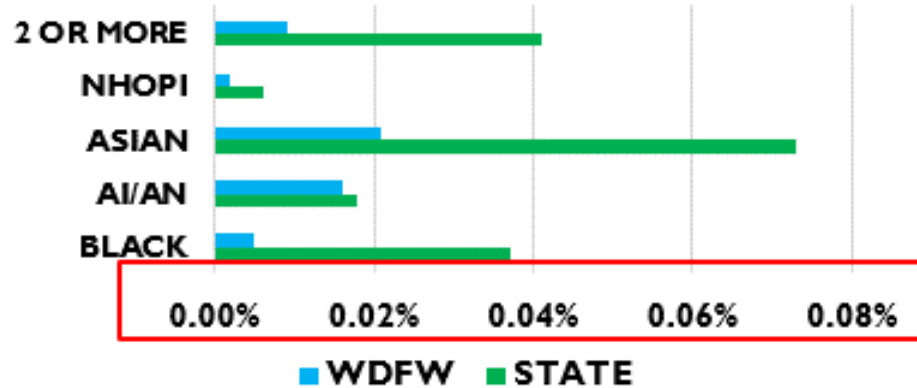
STATE vs. WDFW DEMOGRAPHICS

RACE & ETHNICITY

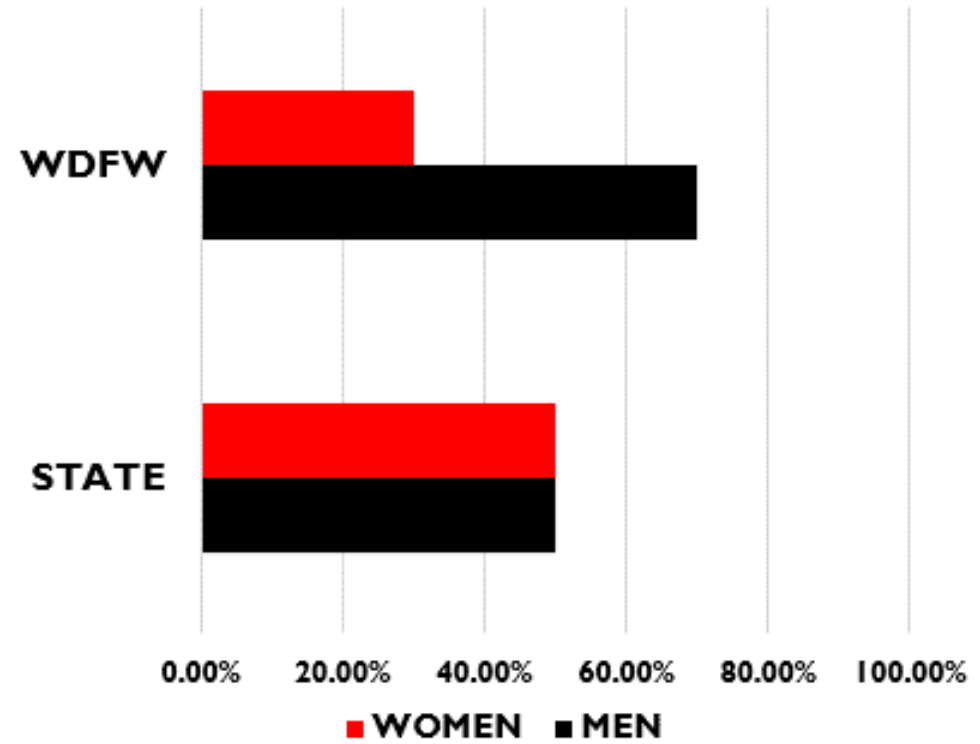
WHITE & HISPANIC
