

SEPA DNS 21-055 Porrás Grass Carp

Mr. Porrás met the screening requirements recommended by habitat biologist Megan Tuttle in September of 2021. According to WDFW Policy – 5103 Planting Triploid Grass Carp: *Only the Director may authorize (WAC 232-12-271) the planning of triploid grass carp into the waters of the state.* This policy states “*Planting rates for aquatic vegetation control objectives may range from 5 to 10 grass carp per surface acre of targeted vegetation*”. If approved by the Director, I would recommend planting a total of 10 grass carp into the water body on Mr. Porrás’s property to attempt to control the aquatic vegetation growth.
