## Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

### Updates: Mainstem and tributary

#### *Columbia River Mainstem*

##### Sturgeon:

##### **Columbia River, Buoy 10 upstream to Bonneville Dam, including adjacent tributaries:**

Catch and release fishing only. Fishing for sturgeon at night is closed.

##### **Bonneville Pool:**

Effective January 1, 2022 until the annual guideline has been met: Open 7 days per week for retention of sturgeon between 38" and 54" fork length.

##### **The Dalles Pool:**

Effective January 1 through January 26, 2022: Open Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays only for retention of sturgeon between 43" and 54" fork length. Catch and release fishing for sturgeon is allowed on days not open to retention.

##### **John Day Pool:**

Effective January 1, 2022 until the annual guideline has been met: Open 7 days per week for retention of sturgeon between 43" and 54" fork length.
