Good afternoon Alicia,

Thank you for your review of the Little Green Lake Dam Safety Repair SEPA checklist and for your continued assistance as we develop appropriate mitigation for the unavoidable project impacts. The Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) proposes to upgrade the Little Green Lake dam spillway (located in Okanogan County) to meet the Inflow Design Flood (IDF) with adequate freeboard as required by the Washington State Department of Ecology Dam Safety Program. The existing spillway does not pass a 500-year flood event, and therefore is not suitable for extreme events. Our project team will be sure to coordinate closely with your program, Okanogan County, the Army Corps of Engineers, and all other relevant stakeholders as we submit our permit applications and develop a suitable mitigation plan.
