A. Motorized Mining Equipment Petition – Briefing, Decision

Margen Carlson, Habitat Director, Josh Peters, Protection Division Manager, and Theresa Nation, Environmental Planner briefed the Commission on a petition to amend WAC 220-660-300 & WAC 220-660-305 to allow use of motorized mining equipment, including but not limited to recirculating systems, which involve no need for an HPA or discharge to waters of the state.

Commissioner Smith made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Ragen, to deny the petition from Dennis Petersen, received by the department on February 28, 2022, to amend rules for mineral prospecting and mining in WAC 220-660-300 and WAC 220-660-305. All in favor. Motion passes.
