RE: DNS 22-017, Ponds 4 and 5 Access Redevelopment
I-82 milepost 47.44 right, Flint Lane

We have reviewed the proposed project and have the following comments.

- The subject property is adjacent to Interstate 82 (I-82). WSDOT has acquired all access rights to the interstate from the subject property. Direct access to I-82 is prohibited. Access to the site is available via the Flint Lane crossing of I-82 at milepost 47.44. If this access is not feasible for construction activity, WDFW should contact Jacob Prilucik at (509) 577-1635 to discuss what, if any, alternative access options are available.
- The existing WSDOT fence typically lies one foot inside our right-of-way boundary and must not be altered or moved without prior WSDOT approval.
- Permanent structures should be setback a sufficient distance to accommodate all on-site activities. Encroachment into I-82 right-of-way for any maintenance or operational activities is prohibited.
