- All participants **MUST** have attended a "Fish Friendly" best fishing practices workshop and have in their immediate possession a department-issued certification card.
- **Retention of White or Green Sturgeon Prohibited.** Please report ALL encounters to Wholesale Dealer or through the Quick Reporting phone, fax, or email.

- Live box use REQUIRED for All Steelhead.
- No minimum Soak times required
- Notice of Intent to fish any of the days in the 2022 fisheries is REQUIRED by 5 pm, September 21, 2022.
