DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: DNS 22-049: DOWNLIST AMERICAN COLUMBIA WHITE-TAILED

DEER FROM ENDANGERED TO THREATENED IN THE STATE OF

WASHINGTON

Description of Proposal:

WDFW proposes to downlist and reclassify Columbia white-tailed deer in the state of Washington under WAC 220-200-100. Anticipated effects include recognizing the progress towards recovery of the species and a reduced conservation concern and prioritization. However the species will still be classified under RCW 77.15.130 offering continued protections from malicious take or harassment.

The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife bases its proposal to downlist Columbia white-tailed deer from Endangered to Threatened on scientific information contained in its report *Washington State Periodic Status Review for the Columbia White-tailed Deer*. This report summarizes evidence that the Columbia white-tailed deer population is increasing and no longer meets the definition of Endangered in the state. However, there is still existing concern around the historically low population size in the state and its vulnerability. The report recommends that the species be reclassified as a Threatened species.

The population along the Columbia River has grown in the last five years. This contrasts with the preceding few years where growth was stagnant, and a longer period of decline before that. Recent increases in overall CRP numbers are attributed mostly to a successful translocation of CWTD to Ridgefield NWR. Most other larger subpopulations have shown either small population increases or decreases.

WDFW is also incorporating the draft Periodic Status Review by reference.
