#### DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS) AND ADOPTION OF EXISTING ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT (CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION)

# Name of Proposal: DNS/Adoption 22-058: ROZA DIVERSION DAM FISH SCREEN REPLACEMENT

#### **Description of Proposal:**

During the non-irrigation seasons of 2023 and 2024, Reclamation proposes to convert the Roza Canal headworks and fish screen structure, consisting of large rotating drum screens (that do not meet fish passage criteria and are beyond their service life) located in five trash rack protected bays that terminate in a fish collector and bypass system, to a new system of in-river submerged, rotating, self-baffling, and self-cleaning T-screens. Modifications proposed to the screening area include saw-cutting the existing concrete headwalls and placing new concrete support structures for the slide gates and tracks associated with the new screens. Ten 8-foot diameter by 31.5-feet long stainless steel, wedge-wire T-screens would be installed in-river for this project.

The construction for the fish screen would take place in two stages—there would be two years of construction, anticipated to be 2023/24 and 2024/25, which would each take place within an October 15 through March 31 in-water work window. This SEPA determination covers both stages of the work.

WDFW has made a Determination of Non-Significance and is adopting a NEPA Categorical Exclusion under SEPA rules.
