Thank you for reviewing and submitting comments for SEPA # 23-006 for the Million Dollar Mile North Access Redevelopment project. Best Management Practices (BMPs) for erosion and sediment control will be used at the construction site and adjacent areas to prevent upland sediments from entering surface water in accordance with the Washington State Departments of Ecology 2019 Stormwater Management Manual for Eastern Washington. A Floodplain Development Permit will be applied for and received from the Grant County prior to commencing with development activities.
