# COLUMBIA RIVER ACTION NOTICE

The following action was taken:

<i>2023 Mainstem Columbia River Spring Chinook Recreational Fishery</i>		
<b>Downstream of Bonneville Dam</b>		
<b>Season:</b>	Thursday May 25 through Sunday June 4	11 days
<b>Area:</b>	Tongue Point/Rocky Point line upstream to Beacon Rock (boat and bank) plus bank angling only from Beacon Rock upstream to the Bonneville Dam deadline. Legal upstream boat boundary defined as: A deadline marker on the Oregon bank (approximately four miles downstream from Bonneville Dam Powerhouse One) in a straight line through the western tip of Pierce Island to a deadline marker on the Washington bank at Beacon Rock.	
<b>Daily Bag</b>	Two adult hatchery salmonids (Chinook or steelhead) per day, but only one may be a Chinook.	
<b>Limit:</b>	All previously adopted regulations, including permanent regulations, remain in effect.	

## FUTURE MEETINGS

- The Compact/Joint State hearing is scheduled for 11 AM June 1, 2023 to consider additional non-treaty spring Chinook fisheries.
