Permit conditions

1. The permittee will cut wood from slash piles at the location shown on the attached map.
2. The permittee is only allowed to use motorized vehicles to access slash piles. Other cross-county vehicle travel is prohibited.
3. Some non-green dot roads marked with "No Unauthorized Vehicles" signs can be used to access slash piles. See the attached map for roads available to permittees.
4. This permit is for wood removal for personal domestic use only. The permittee will not sell, give away, or exchange any of the wood removed.
5. Permittee is required to verify Industrial Fire Precaution Level (IFPL) by checking the Washington Department of Natural Resources website (dnr.wa.gov/ifpl) prior to operating chainsaws during high fire danger periods.
6. The signed and approved permit must be in possession during wood cutting and transport.
7. All ditches and roads will be left open and repaired by the permittee if damaged by permittee's activities. Trees will not be moved to block roads.
8. All vehicles on state land must comply with the Washington's Discover Pass law (RCW 79A.80.080). To prevent fires, do not park on dry vegetation.

9. The permittee will comply with all regulations governing state forest as set forth in "Forest and Forest Producers" RCW Title 76.
10. The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife reserves the right to cancel or suspend this permit at any time. In the event of noncompliance with this permit, all monies held under this permit shall be forfeited.
11. The permittee shall save harmless the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife and all representatives from all suits, actions, and claims of any character brought on account of any neglect in safeguarding permittee's operations, or on account of any act or omission by the permittee or from any claims or amount arising or recovered under the Workmen's Compensation Laws, or any other law, by-laws, ordinances, order, or decree.
12. The permittee shall not cut or remove more than 5 cords at a value of \$10.00 per cord for a total value of \$50.
