Thank you for your comments and review of SEPA DNS 19-011, Sol Duc Salmon Hatchery Access Redevelopment Project. We are looking forward to improving access to the Sol Duc River at this site.

In regards to temporary erosion and sediment control measures to ensure water quality, project construction plans show effective BMPs to restrict sediment mobility caused by work on the site. In addition to physical barriers, clearing, grading, and other associated work will be done in dry weather conditions where possible. No runoff from construction activities will be discharged to the Sol Duc River in compliance with RCW 90.48 and WAC 173-201A.

There are no known soil or ground water contaminants on site. If found, the proper actions, as outlined in your comment letter, will be followed.

We thank you for your time in review of our project and we look forward to continued work with the Department of Ecology.
