Infanticide Definition

The killing of an infant.



Sexually Selected Infanticide

The killing of a female's newborns by an unrelated male so as to bring the female back into estrus for breeding.

Sexually Selected Infanticide is most common in territorial species

BLACK BEARS ARE NOT CONSIDERED TERRITORIAL

Black bears have exhibited infanticide in two studied populations

- Florida (Garrison et al. 2007)
- Arizona (LeCount 1987)




Black bears did NOT exhibit infanticide in other studied populations

- Alberta, Canada (Czetwertynski et al. 2007)
- Michigan (Norton et al. 2018)




In the few instances where infanticide has been observed, it is thought to be driven by density-dependence.


Density-dependence is more common in unhunted populations or areas with poor habitat quality/availability.
