Instructions:

- 1. Print a copy of the template and tape it on your pumpkin.
- 2. Transfer the design to the pumpkin by poking small holes along the black lines using a thumb tack or pumpkin carving tool.
- 3. Remove the template (but be sure to keep it as a reference) and begin cutting out the design left on your pumpkin. Add some detail if you like!
- 4. Add a light and watch your animal glow!

Bald Eagle

Have you ever seen a Bald eagle soaring high in the sky and wondered, "what are they doing up there?" Bald eagles have incredibly keen eyesight, and they use that sense to help them hunt. Their eyesight is 8x more powerful than ours. That means they can see an animal the size of a rabbit from up to three miles away!
