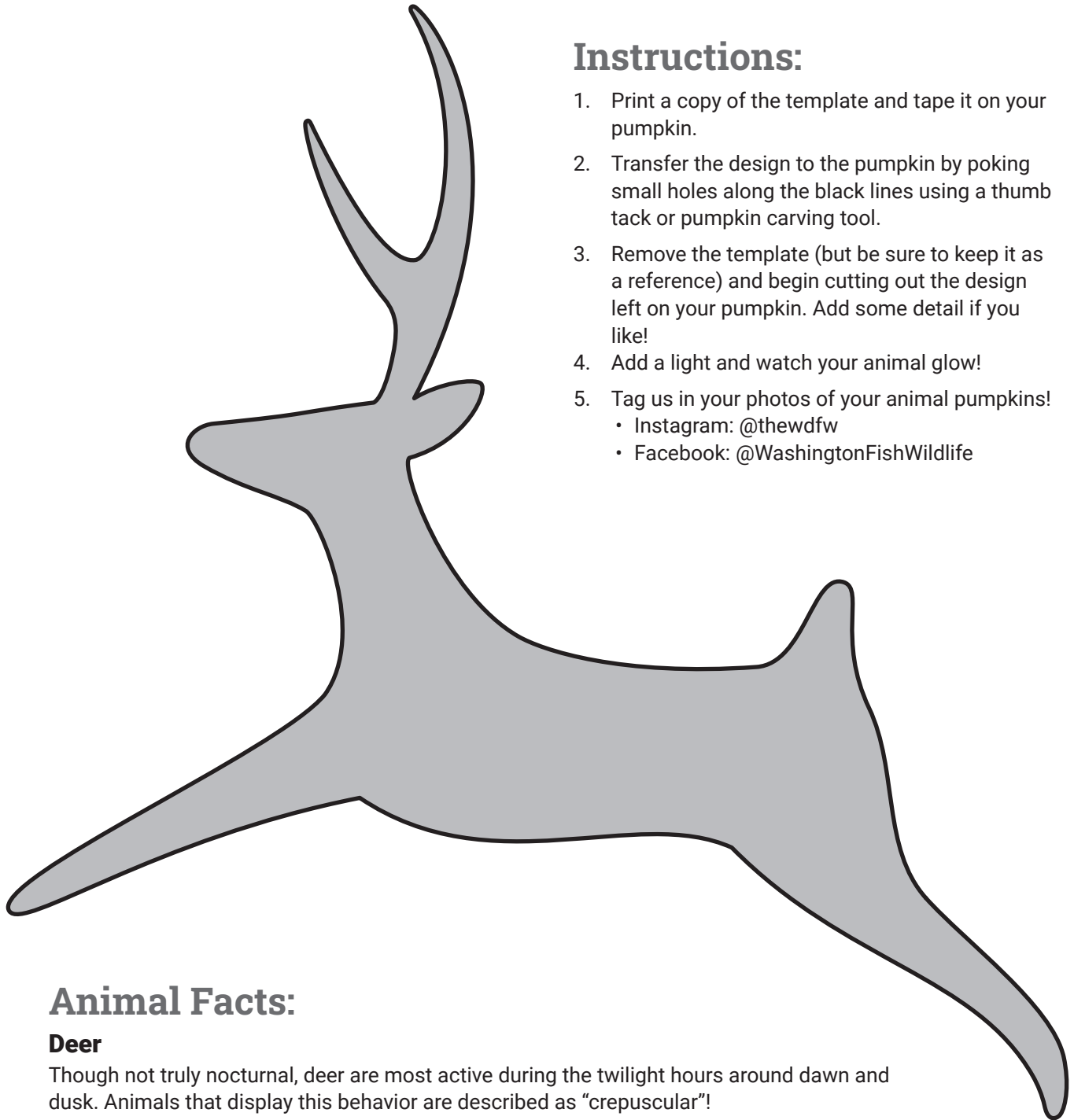

# Wild Washington Deer Pumpkin Carving Template



## Instructions:

1. Print a copy of the template and tape it on your pumpkin.
2. Transfer the design to the pumpkin by poking small holes along the black lines using a thumb tack or pumpkin carving tool.
3. Remove the template (but be sure to keep it as a reference) and begin cutting out the design left on your pumpkin. Add some detail if you like!
4. Add a light and watch your animal glow!

### Deer

Though not truly nocturnal, deer are most active during the twilight hours around dawn and dusk. Animals that display this behavior are described as “crepuscular”!
