- Restoration and Protection (new and portfolio)
- Shore Friendly Program
- Pre-Design Projects
- Small Grants Program

This ESRP Program technical review process is the culmination of years of work together with over 50 regional technical reviewers with expertise in science, policy, and implementation and thousands of hours of meetings and site visits with dozens of project sponsors. This comprehensive integrated list contains priority Puget Sound nearshore recovery work through restoration, protection, landowner incentives, and pre-design projects. This work supports voluntary projects that are supported in local communities, restore key fisheries, and provide local jobs across the Sound.

*This year, ESRP provided project sponsors the opportunity to include a supplemental funding request for projects creating the alternative list titled "Supplemental Funding" allowing project managers to request a larger ESRP grant requiring fewer individual grants to manage, building local capacity.
