AMENDMENT 1 OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LOWER ELWHA KLALLAM INDIAN TRIBE AND THE WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE REGARDING HUNTING CO-MANAGEMENT

Per Section 9.A. of the HUNTING CO-MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE (WDFW) AND THE LOWER ELWHA KLALLAM INDIAN TRIBE (Tribe), this amendment serves as written agreement between the Tribe and WDFW that:

• Section 3. Term of the original signed 2022 Agreement is revised to read as follows.

3. TERM

This Agreement will become effective as to any party upon the signature of that party to this Agreement. Either Party may terminate this Agreement by giving 30 days written notice of the party's intent to terminate. Written notice shall be provided by United States Mail to designated contact person (see Section 11) for each party. The 30-day period will begin on the notification date stated in the letter or the postmark date, whichever is later.

• All other provisions of the Agreement, as amended, remain in effect.

The undersigned parties agree that the term of the Agreement in this amendment is extended as described above.
