

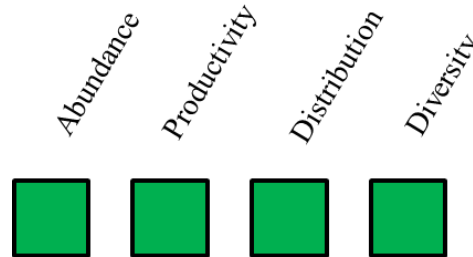
Coastal Steelhead Season Planning: Town Hall #2

Results of Public Process

- ~150 people attended both Town Hall #1 and Town Hall #2
- Hundreds of suggestions through online portal, phone, email, and letters.
- Key Concepts we've heard from the public:
 - Desire for a conservative approach
 - Support for last year's regulations
 - Close systems that are not meeting escapement
 - Increased hatchery targeted fisheries
 - Allow the use of bait
 - Allow steelhead fishing in April
 - Increase boat fishing opportunity
 - Increase restrictions on fishing out of a boat
 - Formal evaluation of boat fishing restrictions
- Region 6 Management team analyzed more than 20 specific proposals

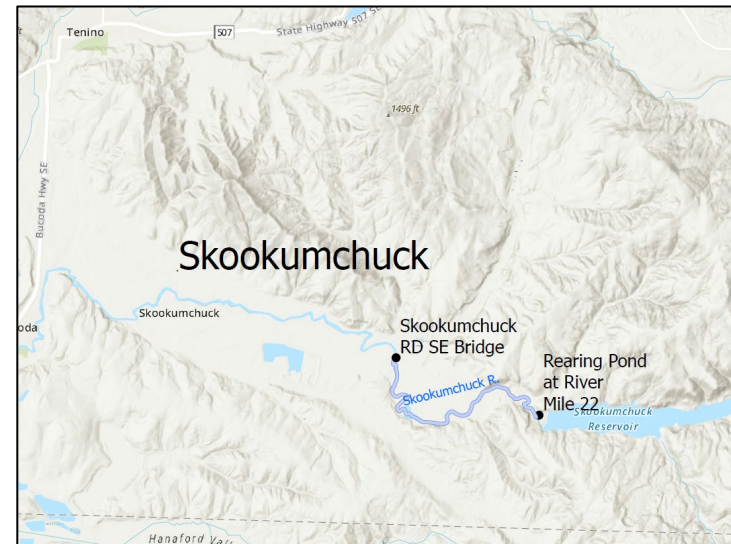

2023/24 Coastal Steelhead Rules

- **Willapa System**-Open December 1-March 31 (select tributaries Feb. 28th), selective gear rules, one single point barbless hook, release wild rainbow trout, 2 hatchery steelhead bag limit. Fishing from a floating device allowed.
- **Chehalis River**-TBD: Comanager conversations ongoing
- **Humptulips River**-TBD: Comanager conversations ongoing
- **Quinault River**- Closed November 30th
- **Queets/Clearwater River**-Closed November 30th
- **Quillayute System**-Open December 1-March 31, selective gear rules, one single point barbless hook. Expanded boat fishing in Sol Duc River. Fishing from a floating device allowed in mainstem Quillayute, below hatchery on Sol Duc, below 101 bridge on Calawah and below mouth of Mill Creek (above hatchery) on Bogachiel. Release wild rainbow trout, 2 hatchery steelhead bag limit.
- **Hoh River**-Open December 1-March 31, selective gear rules, one single point barbless hook. Fishing from a floating device allowed; Wednesday through Saturday from Mouth to Oxbow boat ramp, and Sunday through Tuesday from Oxbow to Morgans Crossing. Release wild rainbow trout, 2 hatchery steelhead bag limit.
