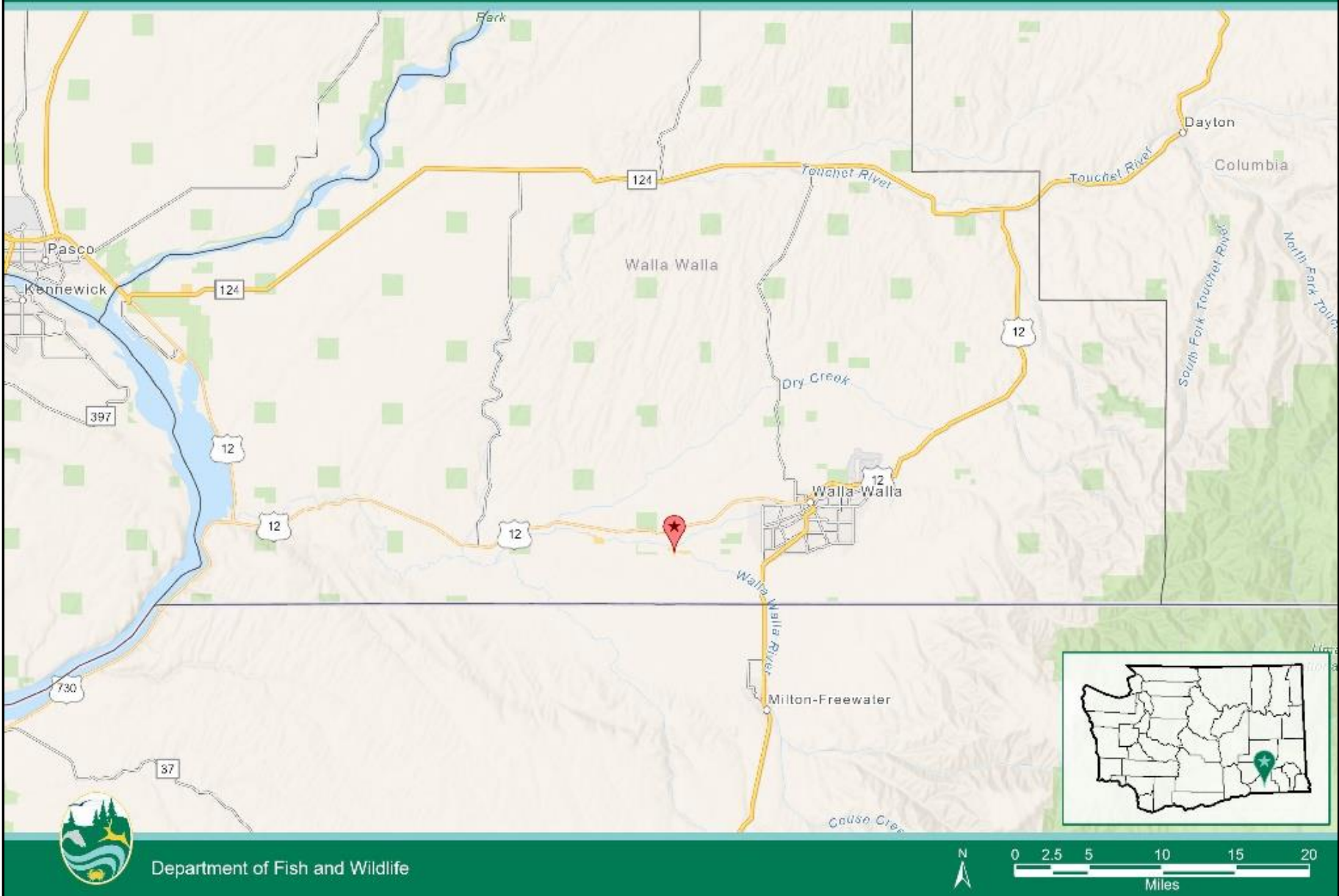

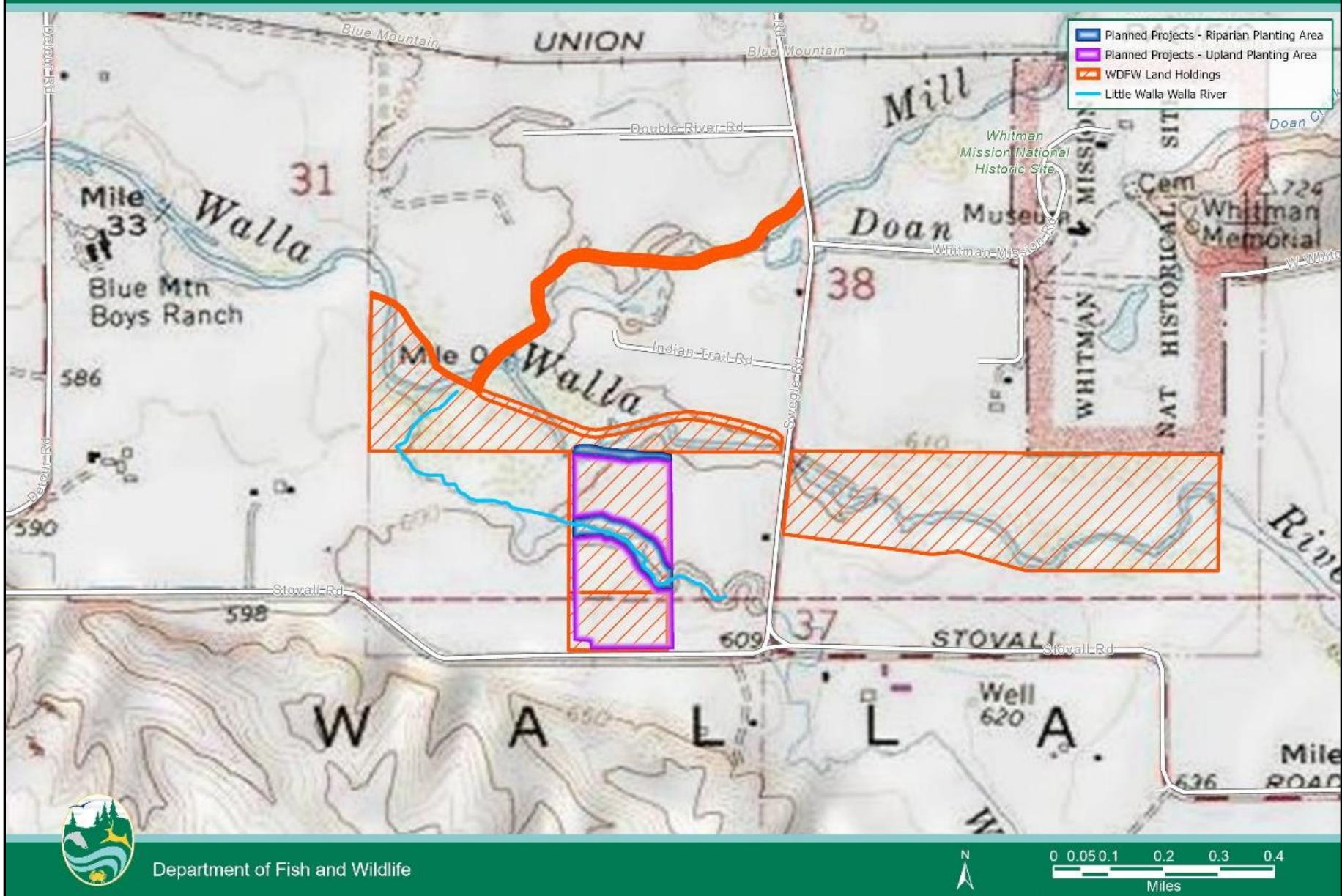
Regional Map

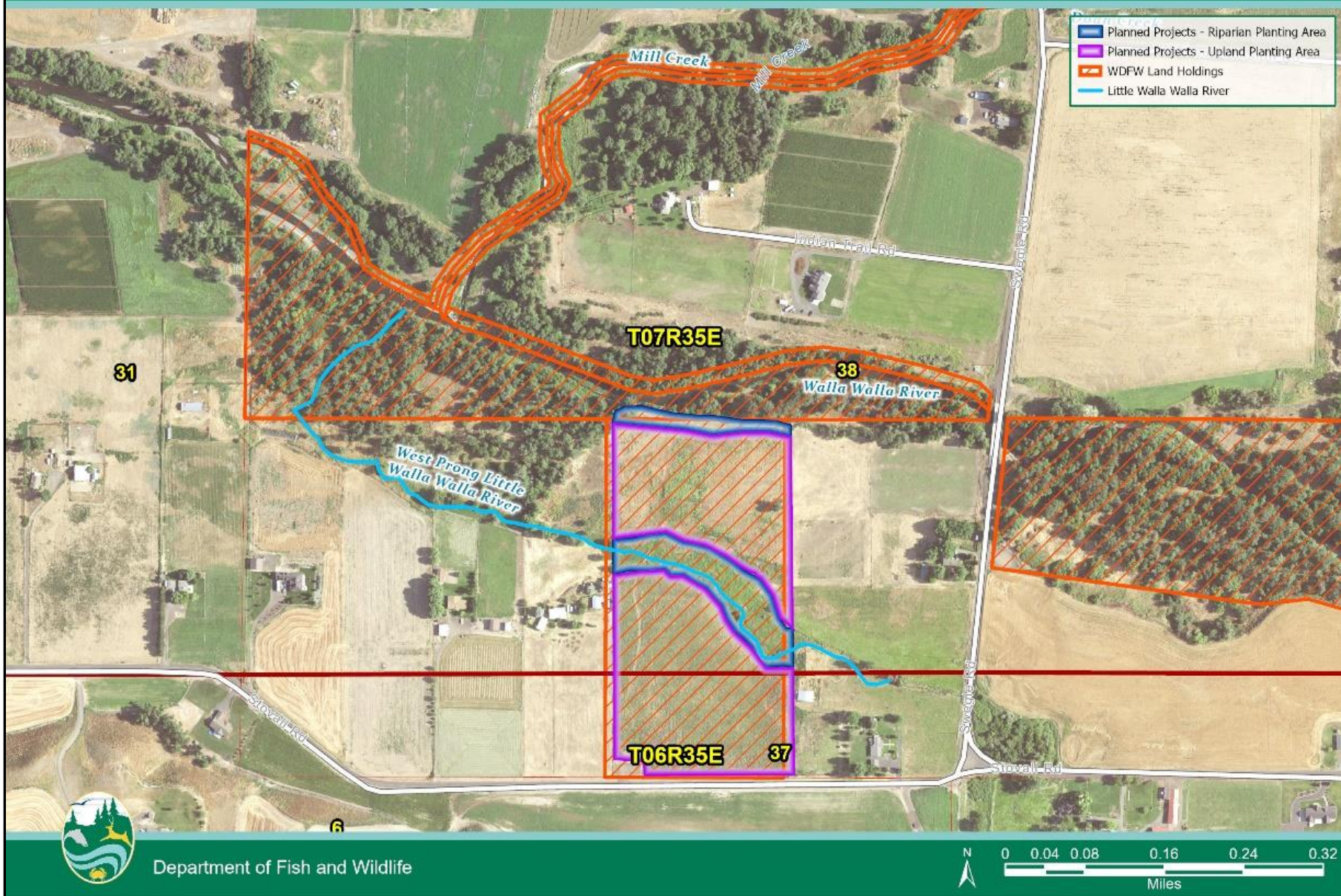
Area of Potential Effect Map

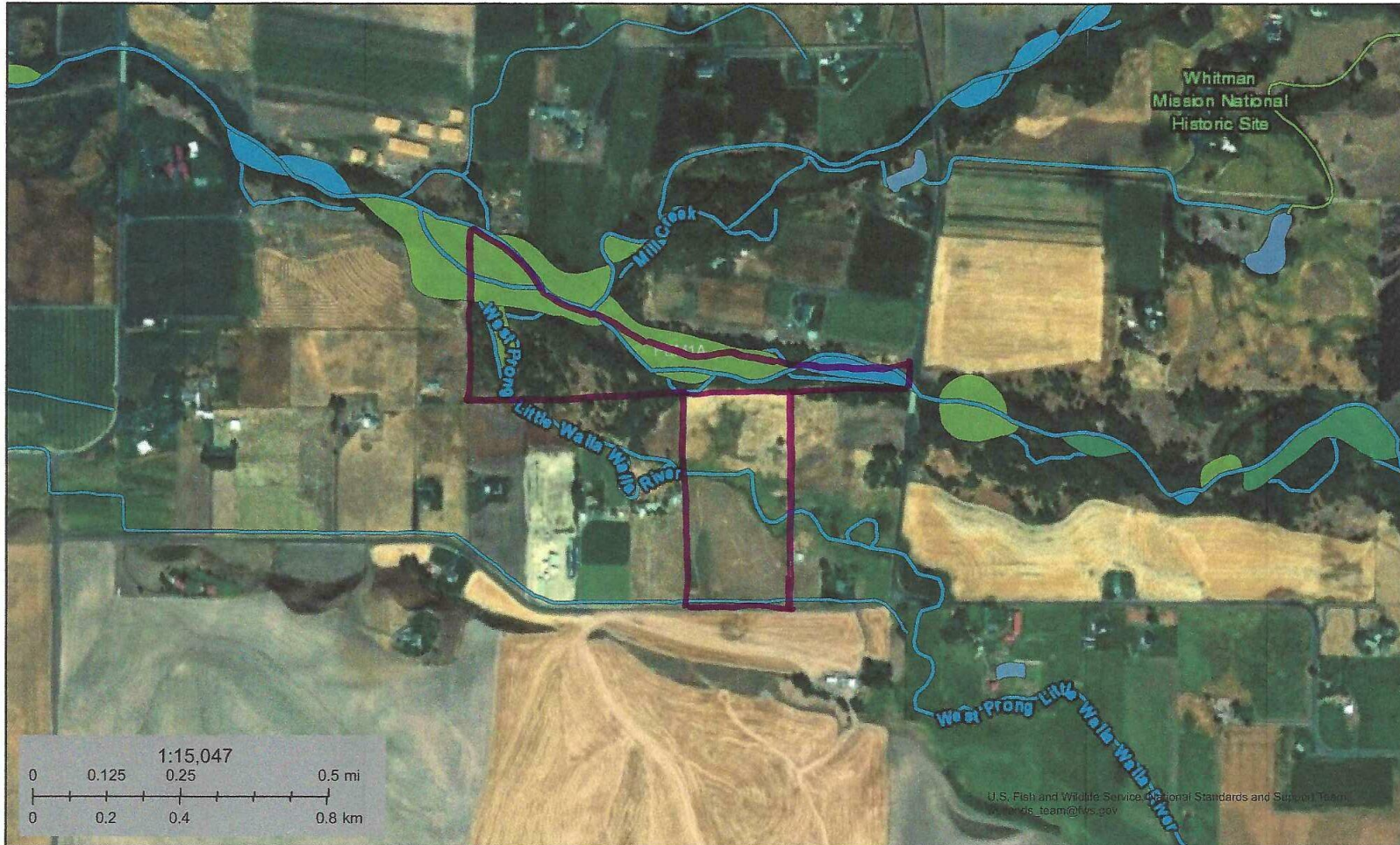
Project Boundary Map

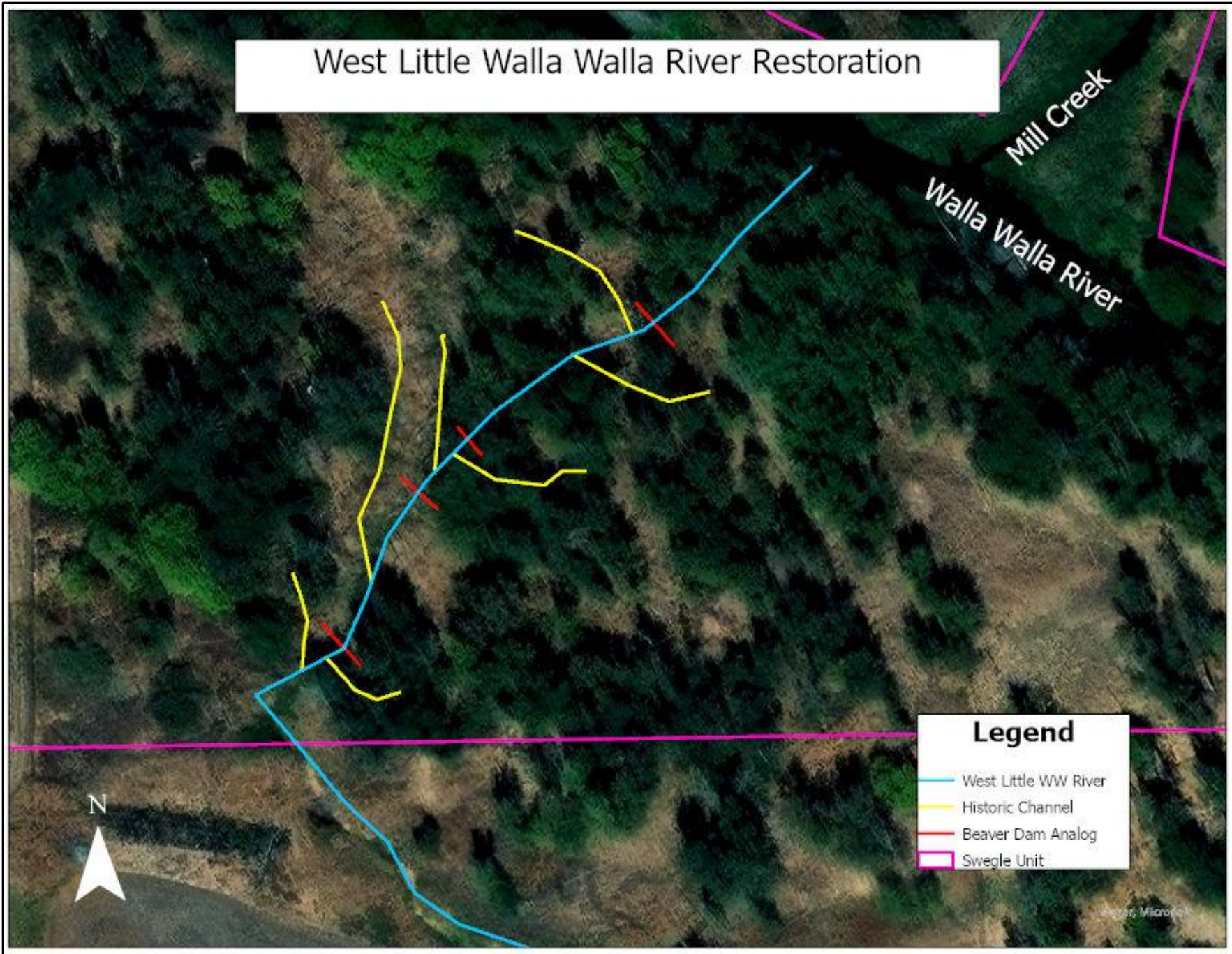

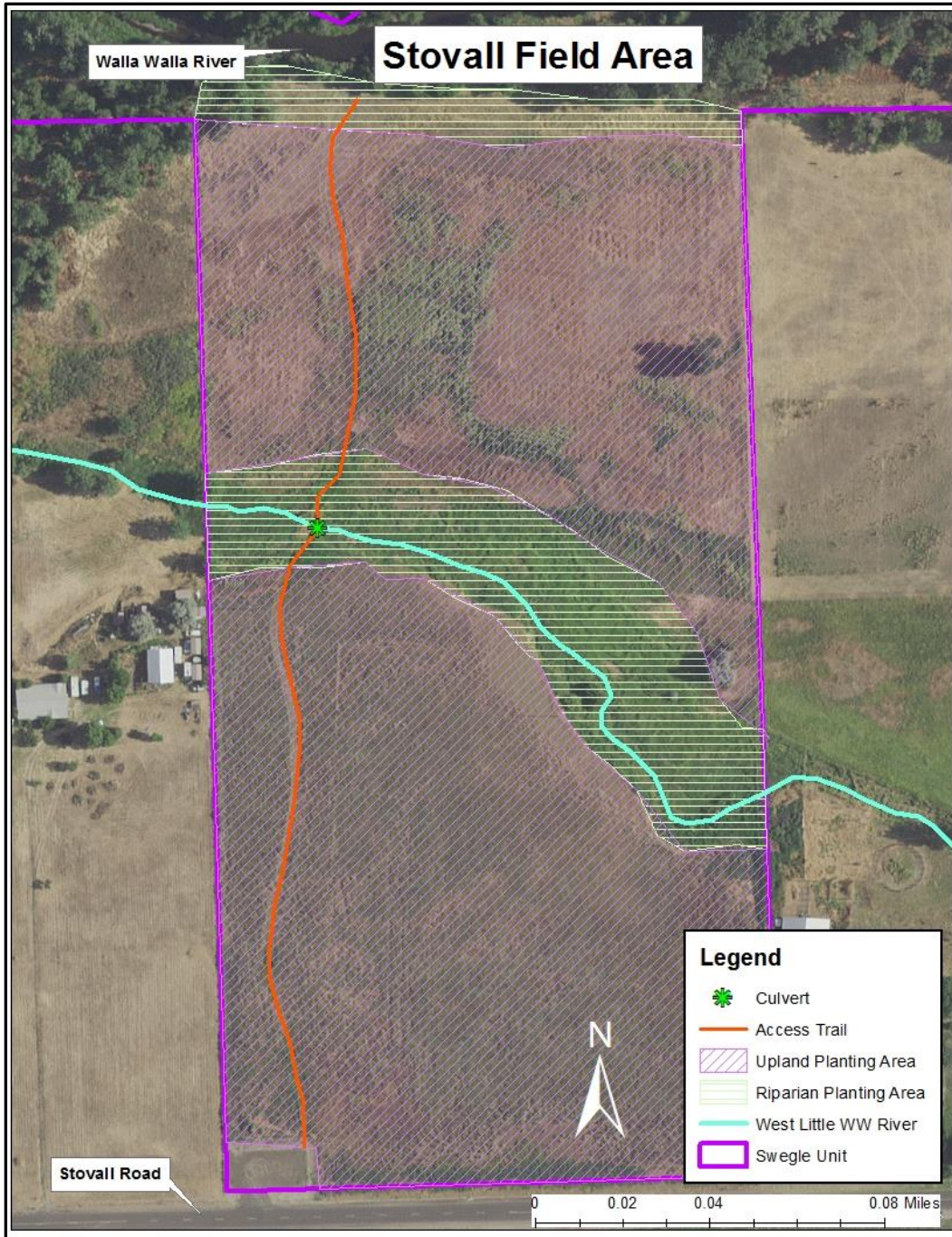
