Our responses to your comments are listed below by topic:

Water Quality – Potential to Discharge Off-Site: We do not anticipate disturbing ground with the potential for stormwater discharge off-site.

Water Quality – Annexation: The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife is not a city and the project will not, under any circumstances, annex property as a first step in a proposed development.

Water Quality – Dividing or Platting: The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife is not dividing or platting a piece of property as a first step in a proposed development.
