		Season:	Saturday June 8 through Saturday June 15 8 retention days
Area:	Tower Island power lines (approximately six miles below The Dalles Dam) upstream to Oregon/Washington border, plus the Oregon and Washington banks between Bonneville Dam and the Tower Island power lines.		
Daily Bag Limit:	Two adult hatchery salmonids (Chinook or steelhead) per day, but only one may be a Chinook.		
	All other permanent regulations apply.		

FUTURE MEETINGS

• No Compact or Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time. The tribes may request a Compact Hearing on June 27 or 28 to consider additional commercial gillnet openings. Joint Staff will monitor fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed.
