The states of Oregon and Washington discussed the following recreational fisheries and took the following action:

## Mainstem Recreational Fisheries

<i>2024 Mainstem Columbia River Recreational Spring Chinook Fishery</i>		
<b>Downstream of Bonneville Dam</b>		
Effective Saturday June 8 through Saturday June 15, the upstream boat boundary is the Bonneville Dam deadline. All previously adopted regulations remain in effect.		
<b>Bonneville Dam to Oregon/Washington Border</b>		
<b>Season:</b>	Saturday June 8 through Saturday June 15	8 retention days
<b>Area:</b>	Tower Island power lines (approximately six miles below The Dalles Dam) upstream to Oregon/Washington border, plus the Oregon and Washington banks between Bonneville Dam and the Tower Island power lines.	
<b>Daily Bag Limit:</b>	Two adult hatchery salmonids (Chinook or steelhead) per day, but only one may be a Chinook.	
	All other permanent regulations apply.	

## FUTURE MEETINGS

- No Compact or Joint State hearings are scheduled at this time. The tribes may request a Compact Hearing on June 27 or 28 to consider additional commercial gillnet openings. Joint Staff will monitor fisheries and recommend additional hearings as needed.
