Columbia River and Tributary Fishery Reports

Lower Columbia River, Rocky Point/Tongue Point line upstream to Bonneville Dam – 75 salmonid boats and 173 Washington bank rods were tallied during Saturday's (6/29) flight count.

Mainstem Columbia River

<u>Salmon/Steelhead</u>:

Sec 1 (Bonneville) – 36 bank anglers kept eight sockeye, released one Chinook, two steelhead and two sockeye. 1 boat/2 rods had no catch.
