Good afternoon Aaron,

This email is in response to the WSDOT comments (attached) provided to WDFW during the SEPA public comment period for the US Bureau of Reclamation (Reclamation) - Roza Dam Fish Ladder Sediment Removal project.

In response to your first comment, Reclamation will utilize the grandfathered approach at milepost 6.16 of State Route 821 (SR 821) for site access to the proposed project. Site access would not occur from any additional properties.

In response to your second comment, Reclamation would adhere to any and all WSDOT regulations for loads transported on WSDOT rights-of-way including obtaining necessary overweight permits, if needed. No debris/sediment would be transported on State Route 821. All debris/sediment would remain with the proposed project area. In the event of any debris/sediment being spilled within WSDOT rights-of-way, Reclamation would promptly clean that spilled material.
