Salmon fishing is allowed during open season dates only from the Whatcom Creek mouth (a line from the flashing light at the south-west end of the Port of Bellingham North Terminal to the southern-most point of the dike surrounding the Georgia Pacific treatment pond) upstream to the footbridge below Dupont Street in Bellingham.

A valid fishing license and salmon Catch Record Card are required.
