Dear Coastal Dungeness Crab Fishery Participant:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) is hosting an industry meeting to discuss proposed rules and their implementation in the coastal commercial Dungeness crab fishery on Thursday September 12, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

This meeting will review the proposed rules for updated line marking requirements and surface gear maximums. The proposed requirements include marking the surface line and vertical line (line connecting the pot to the main buoy). Enhanced line marking is needed to identify gear used in the Washington coastal commercial Dungeness crab fishery and improve whale entanglement reporting. WDFW has been working closely with Oregon and California Fish and Wildlife agencies, NOAA Fisheries, and stakeholders on developing line marking requirements for the West Coast crab fisheries. Surface gear maximums are an entanglement risk reduction strategy.
