



## Chief Joseph Exchange, Asotin County

- WDFW property has a spring that exchange landowner uses for livestock
- Exchange owner has 13 acres inside the boundary fence of the WLA
- Simplifies landownership and management
- Habitat: curl leaf mahogany stands, native grassland, Ponderosa pine woodlands
- Species: Elk, mule deer, cougar, big horn sheep, grouse, steelhead
- Recreation: Removes an inaccessible 10acre parcel and provides 13-acre parcel the public can easily access for a variety of activities including hunting and hiking
