WASHINGTON COASTAL DUNGENESS CRAB INDUSTRY NOTICE

Season Opening Delayed in Washington

In consultation with Dungeness crab Tri-State fishery managers from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) and California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), WDFW is delaying the opening of the 2024-25 WA Coastal Dungeness crab fishery. On November 20, 2024, Tri-State fishery managers agreed on a coastwide delay from Point Area, CA to the US/Canada border through at least December 15th. This decision was based on crab condition tests results from multiple test areas that do not currently meet the minimum meat recovery criteria.

Tri-State Dungeness crab Pre-Season Testing Protocols specify that after the first round of testing, if any area does not meet the minimum meat recovery criteria (23% north of Cascade Head and 24% south of Cascade Head) a delay is required, and additional testing is conducted before a season opening date can be confirmed. A second round of meat recovery is scheduled to be conducted in early December. WDFW will provide additional information regarding the season opening as soon as possible following the completion of the upcoming tests.

WASHINGTON TEST RESULTS

Sampling within the Long Beach Test Area was completed on November 7, 2024. Round 1 testing within the Westport Test Area was not completed due to inclement weather. WDFW plans to complete Round 2 testing within both the Westport and Long Beach Test Areas before December 7, 2024.

- 1A: no flex in body or legs; marketable
- 1B: slight flex in either body or leg; marketable
- II: some flex in both body and leg; not marketable
- III: extreme flex in body and legs; not marketable
