The Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) welcomes comments on proposed projects. This response will address issues in the order they appear in the August 14, 2024 comments.

Shorelines and Environmental Assistance: WDFW will be seeking shoreline permits from Clallam County and the Department of Ecology (ECY). Lizzie Carp at Ecology will be consulted as needed.

WDFW will ensure grading and filling will only utilize clean fill. Any excess material will be disposed of in an approved upland site by the yet-to-be-selected contractor. Derek Rockett will be contacted as necessary.

WDFW does not anticipate any toxic cleanup, but should something come up the ERTS form will be used and Tim Mullen contacted as necessary.
