Inspection/Decontamination Compliance Verification

Aquatic conveyances—including but not limited to boats, trailers, engines, any water containers, and associated equipment—that will be used during this fishing contest have been in waters outside of Washington within the last 30 days. As a result, I attest, under penalty of perjury and all applicable Washington state laws, that the following steps have been taken in accordance with **WAC 220-220-220**.

An authorized inspector, such as Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) staff at an aquatic invasive species (AIS) inspection station, a representative from a municipality, an enforcement officer, etc., has inspected all aquatic conveyances, detected no AIS, and determined decontamination is not required. All aquatic conveyances have been decontaminated by hot water wash with a contact time of at least 130 seconds. Minimum water temperature for the interior wash is 120 °F and the exterior is 140 °F. Decontamination must occur for all surfaces that have had contact with water, including but not limited to the hull, transom, engine, bilge, live wells, and fishing equipment.
