## **Tributary Fishery Reports**

## **Columbia River Tributaries**

## Salmon/Steelhead

**Cowlitz River I-5 Br downstream** – 98 bank rods kept one Chinook and released two steelhead. 2 boats/4 rods had no catch.

Cowlitz River Above the I-5 Br - 46 bank rods kept five Chinook and released one Chinook. 4 boats/11 rods kept three Chinook, one jack, and released two Chinook.

**Kalama River** – 39 bank anglers kept five Chinook, two jacks, one steelhead, and released one steelhead. 20 boats/52 rods kept 12 Chinook, one steelhead, and released one steelhead.

**Lewis River** – 33 bank rods kept eight Chinook and one jack. 14 boats/34 rods kept eight Chinook and released one steelhead.

**Wind River** – Four bank anglers had no catch. 64 boats/173 rods kept 44 Chinook and released two Chinook.

**Little White Salmon (Drano Lake)** – 49 bank anglers kept 11 Chinook. 158 boats/456 rods kept 172 Chinook, released two Chinook and one steelhead.

Klickitat River below Fisher Hill Bridge – Two bank anglers had no catch.
