Agency Request Legislation

- 1. Increase the renewal fee for personalized license plates
- 2. Increase efficacy of enforcement for fish and wildlife violations

Personalized License Plate Renewal Fee

- Personalized license plate fees are \$52 initial and \$42 renewal.
- WDFW is proposing a \$10 increase for the renewal from \$42 to \$52.
- Projected revenue = \$838,000 per fiscal year beginning in FY26.

Enforcement violation options

Background

- During the 2020 session, significant additions to civil infraction authority were created.
- The changes were related to recreational fishing and small game along with agency permits.
- These changes have been very successful, and WDFW is now requesting similar changes for big game violations and low-level commercial guide and charter violations.



Enforcement violation options

Increased infraction authority has relieved prosecutors from addressing low-level criminal conduct and allowed for meaningful deterrence options for minor violations.

The proposal includes infraction authority for

- Certain big game violations
- Certain firearm violations
- Certain hydraulic violations
- Low-level fishing guide and charter violations

- Puget Sound nonspot shrimp pot license
- Wolf management
