Randi Thurston welcomed and thanked everyone for their participation on this group.

Review:

Randi reviewed the pre-proposal rule changes and explained the department's reason for recommending the change. One member asked WDFW to investigate the possibility of including non-compliance with HPA provisions among the criteria for revoking an HPA. Another member asked how a person would know whether a fish habitat improvement structure exists in the area they intend to prospect, and suggested that WDFW consider adding these structures to mapping that could be available within the application management software. Members asked whether WDFW would file a CR102 before the next meeting of the HCICAG and indicated a preference for meeting again prior to the filing.
