



Dear Mr. Beich:

The Department of Ecology has set aside \$500,000 to clean up the Dryden site you and I discussed.

The \$500,000 would become available July 1, 2013, and would need to be spent by June 30, 2015. There would be no match requirement. This money would come from Ecology's Clean Sites Initiative funding. Typically, an interagency agreement is the administrative vehicle we use to funnel the money to your agency.

Ecology would provide you with a site manager to oversee the cleanup and ensure costs are spent in the most efficient manner.
