


- WAC 232-28-248

- Also would allow .40 caliber or larger semi-auto handguns during modern






WAC 232-28-337 Proposals:


- Adjust boundaries on Elk Area 1040 and Elk Area 1013 to accommodate hunts on 4-0 Ranch Wildlife Area


- Create EA 5066 Norway Pass
