
Early Archery

- For the last 6 years early archery has opened the Tuesday after Labor Day (13 day season)
- Hot weather and fire restrictions have proved problematic under current season structure
- Recommend starting the season Saturday after Labor Day (13 day season)

Muzzleloader Elk

- There are Currently 50 GMUs Without General Muzzleloader Elk Opportunity
- Recommend Opening 27 of Those GMUs to General Muzzleloader Season
 - 26 early general; 1 late general

- Changes in land ownership
- Changes in private land access policy



Elk Season Recommendations

- Move Early Archery to First Sat. After Labor Day
- Open More GMUs to Early Muzzleloader
- Open the Margaret Unit (GMU 524) to General Season
- Increase Antlerless Opportunity in Colockum Through Special Permits and General Archery
- Reduce Antlerless Special Permits for Mount St. Helens and Yakima to Stabilize Population
- Adjust ↑↓ Special Permits via Special Permit Allocation Formula
- Adjust Antierless Special Permits to Address Population Control and/or Agricultural Damage Issues
