Why a Supplemental Rule Proposal?

- Discussion with NE Washington sportsmen

 Concerns for deer population bluetongue
 Similar to 2014 seasons
- April Proposal reduced modern firearm antlerless harvest for youth, senior, and hunters with disabilities
- Intended to propose additional reductions
