

Deer Harvest 2001 to 2016


General Season and Special Permit Combined


Deer General Seasons WAC 232-28-357

- Third year of a 3-year package
- No major changes proposed
- Propose restoring the late archery season in GMUs 204 and 209 to the 2015 structure
- Propose exceptions to GMU 382 general season to accommodate special permit season in Deer Area 5382

Direction and Rationale

- Maintain conservative season structure when necessary
- Retain a hunting season framework that doesn't negatively impact deer populations
- Entertain ideas for major changes in the next 3-year package cycle 2018-2020


Winter Happens








Elk Harvest 2001 to 2016

Elk Population Status

- Yakima herd follow up surveys pending
 - Below objective
 - Likely reduced antlerless special permits
- Colockum herd surveys pending
 - At objective
 - Likely reduced antlerless special permits
- Blue Mountains herd at objective
 Minimal proposed changes

Colockum	At Objective; Surveys Pending	Antlerless Special Permits Likely Reduced; Assessed After surveys
Blue Mountains	At Objective	Slight $\uparrow \downarrow$ on Bull Permits
Mount St. Helens	At Objective for Core	Slight $\uparrow \downarrow$ on Bull Permits
Nooksack	Survey Data Pending	Increase in Bull Special Permits
Olympic	Harvest Data	Status Quo
Willapa Hills	Survey Data Pending	Status Quo

Elk Special Permits WAC 232-28-360

- Yakima antlerless permits will be reduced based on 1st and pending 2nd surveys
- Colockum antlerless permits will be reduced based on pending surveys
- Quality and Bull permits adjusted using the special permit allocation formula
