<p>The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service’s (USFWS) Lower Snake River Compensation Plan (LSRCP) office (Boise, ID) administers funding of LSRCP hatchery operations, maintenance and evaluations. The Office directs hatchery operations toward meeting the program’s mitigation goals and ensures that hatchery operations are conducted in a safe environment, and that they comply with all Federal regulations and Tribal Trust responsibilities.
