Coastal Dungeness Crab Fishery Overview



- 2012-2016 Average Ex-Vessel Revenue: \$36M
- Effort Limitations: 223 Licenses, 200 Active
 - Pot Limits: 300 or 500 Based on Historical Landings (Buoy Tags)
 - Vessel Length Restrictions
 - Trip Limits Beginning July 1 for Softshell Conservation
- Fishery Occurs from about 5 fms to 60 fms
- Season: Dec 1 Sept 15
- Tri-State Agreement with OR and CA
- Annual Harvest Agreements with Coastal Treaty Tribes

Purpose and Need for Rule Changes

Revisions to coastal commercial Dungeness crab regulations are needed to:

- Promote efficiency and reduce costs for fishers,
- Improve enforceability of existing regulations, and
- Streamline administrative processes

While

 Continuing to achieve the primary objectives of the regulations consistent with their original intent.

WAC 220-340-430: Replacement Buoy Tags

Purpose and Need

- Improve enforceability
 - Recent investigations show system abuse
- Streamline administrative process
 - Current timing varies depending on when fishery opens
 (driven by crab quality, public health, and tribal agreements)

Effect

- ~82% of all license holders do not use replacement tags
- Number of replacement tags available to each license holder would be reduced from 10% to 5%
- Process would include specific dates

WAC 220-340-440: Transporting Out-of-State Gear

Purpose and Need

- Promote efficiency and reduce costs to fishers
 - Activity currently prohibited—helps ensure fairness during gear setting period and maintain integrity of pot limits
 - Dual-licensed vessels in Westport truck gear to Ilwaco
 - 2016-17 fishery season delay gear storage issue

<u>Effect</u>

- ~15-20 dual-licensed vessels in Westport
- Require advance notification and WDFW permit with gear location reporting (consistent with logbook requirements)

Proposed Next Steps

- Public comment period open through Aug 5
- Requesting preliminary approval at this meeting
- Based on public input, may recommend revisions for Commission consideration via conference call
- If not, then will confirm no changes and file CR-103
