



PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

CR-101 (June 2004)
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)
Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

Subject of possible rule making: The department is considering new rules to establish new types of combination fishing licenses.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 77.32.050, 77.32.090, and 77.32.470

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

Chapter 77.32 RCW allows the Fish and Wildlife Commission to set the period of validity for a license and to combine licenses to one license at a fee less than the cost of the combined licenses. Creating new combination fishing licenses will increase participation in all angling activities, improve retention of customers, and grow revenue opportunities for the department.
