



PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

CR-101 (June 2004)
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)
Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife

Subject of possible rule making:

Creating, amending, and repealing WACs affected by legislative changes made by passage of House Bill (HB) 1597 and Senate Bill (SB) 5306 during the 2017 legislative session.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 77.04.090, RCW 77.04.130, RCW 77.15.568, RCW 77.08.010, RCW 77.65.510, RCW 77.65.515, RCW 77.65.520

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

HB 1597 introduces new commercial fish license terms that are not currently defined elsewhere in the Fish and Wildlife Code. Because of the passage of both HB 1597 and SB 5306, the department must create a new rule, repeal and amend existing rules.
