NEW SECTION

WAC 232-28-61900W Exceptions to statewide rules—Cascade and North Fork Stiallaguamish rivers.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 232-28-619, effective January 6 through January 31, 2014, it is unlawful to fish in the following waters:

- (1) Cascade River (Tributary of the Skagit River) from the Rockport-Cascade Road downstream to the mouth.
- (2) North Fork Stillaguamish River from the Swede Heaven Bridge downstream four river miles to the French Creek confluence.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective February 1, 2014:

WAC 232-28-61900W Exceptions to statewide rules.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: The Marblemount and Whitehorse hatcheries have been unable to collect enough returning hatchery winter steelhead broodstock to meet egg take needs. Closure of the fisheries are needed to collect sufficient fish to meet egg take needs. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
