## NEW SECTION

# WAC 232-28-61900Y Exceptions to statewide rules—Tokul Creek.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 232-28-619, effective 7:00 a.m. January 9 through 5:00 p.m. January 14, 2014, it is permissible to fish in waters of Tokul Creek from the Fish Hatchery Road Bridge upstream to the posted cable boundary marker below the hatchery intake. Unless otherwise amended, all permanent rules remain in effect.

#### REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective 7:00 a.m. January 15, 2014:

WAC 232-28-61900Y Exceptions to statewide rules—Tokul Creek.

### EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

**Reasons for this finding:** This section of Tokul Creek is closed in the permanent regulations until Jan.15 to allow for winter steelhead broodstock collection at the Tokul Creek Hatchery. The Tokul Creek Hatchery facility has now met their egg take goals for winter steelhead allowing for expanded fishing opportunity in Tokul Creek. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
