## NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-56-36000G Razor clams – Areas and Seasons.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-56-360, it is unlawful to dig for or possess razor clams taken for personal use from any beach in Razor Clam Areas 1, 3, 4, or 5, except as provided in this section:

- (1) Effective 12:01 p.m. January 17, 2014 through 11:59 p.m. January 18, 2014, razor clam digging is allowed in Razor Clam Area 1. Digging is allowed from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (2) Effective 12:01 p.m. January 15, 2014 through 11:59 p.m. January 18, 2014, razor clam digging is allowed in Razor Clam Area 3. Digging is allowed from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (3) Effective 12:01 p.m. January 17, 2014 through 11:59 p.m. January 18, 2014, razor clam digging is allowed in Razor Clam Area 5. Digging is allowed from 12:01 p.m. to 11:59 p.m. each day only.
- (4) It is unlawful to dig for razor clams at any time in Long Beach, Twin Harbors Beach or Copalis Beach Clam sanctuaries as defined in WAC 220-56-372.

#### REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective 12:01 a.m. January 19, 2014:

WAC 220-56-36000G Razor Clams – Areas and Seasons.

#### EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

**Reasons for this finding**: Survey results show that adequate clams are available for harvest in Razor Clam Areas 1, 3 and 5. Washington Department of Health has certified clams from these beaches to be safe for human consumption. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. **(14-07, 1/13/2014)**
