REPEALERS

The following sections of the Washington Administrative Code are repealed effective March 31, 2014, one hour after official sunset:

WAC 220-310-19500A Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Okanogan, Similkameen, Wenatchee and Icicle Rivers. (14-38)

WAC 220-310-20000B Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Columbia River. (14-40)

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.

Reasons for this finding: Most steelhead will be spawning beginning in April. National Marine Fisheries Service Permit 1395 for this program only allows a fishery to be promulgated through March 31. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules. **(14-67, 3/25/2014)**
