## NEW SECTION

## WAC 220-55-17200A Reduced rate combination deer hunting licenses.

There is hereby created a combination deer hunting license that allows the holder to hunt deer for the purpose described below. A person purchasing any big game license that includes deer may purchase a reduced rate combination license combining the deer license with a multiseason deer permit. If a hunter is drawn for a multi-season deer permit, consistent with the rules of the commission and conditions of the department, they may purchase a multi-season deer permit. The fee for this combined license is thirty-nine dollars less than the sum of the big game license containing deer and the multi-season permit.
