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NEW SECTION

WAC 220-310-19000G Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

Notwithstanding the provisions of WAC 220-310-195, effective immediately until further notice, it is permissible to fish for and possess game fish taken from the waters of Rattlesnake Lake for personal use one hour before official sunrise on October 18, 2014, to one hour after official sunset on February 1, 2015.

- (1) Daily limit of 10 trout; no size restrictions.
- (2) Selective gear rules apply.

REPEALER

The following section of the Washington Administrative Code is repealed effective February 2, 2015:

WAC 220-310-19000G Freshwater exceptions to statewide rules—Puget Sound.

EMERGENCY RULE ONLY

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- (x) That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- () That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.
- () That in order to implement the requirements or reductions in appropriations enacted in any budget for fiscal years 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012 or 2013, which necessitates the need for the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the fiscal needs or requirements of the agency.

Reasons for this finding: The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife will increase winter recreational opportunity in inland waters throughout the Puget Sound region by stocking more than 300,000 catchable-size (10 to 12 inches) or larger rainbow trout. Changes to rules are needed to provide for the additional opportunity enabled by the stocking. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.
